


The National Context

- National entitlement to fully fund eligible adults with no or low digital skills to enrol on specified digital qualifications at Entry level and Level 1 from August 2020
- Only Essential Digital Skills qualifications can be used for the legal entitlement
- Essential Digital Skills qualifications now available at Entry 3 and Level 1










INTERACTIVE SELF-ASSESSMENT TOOL

To start on your training, you will need to complete your self-assessment. This will:


- Help you to reflect on your existing skills and experience

MODULES


- 20 modules to cover the standards
- Each about 15 minutes long
- Each module with this format:



Introduction shows list of the chapters and overview: what you need to know to teach this area

MODULE DEVELOPMENT

Each chapter follows this format:



ASSESSMENT

- 8 questions
- Overall feedback to tell you how you did
- Each question gives feedback if answered incorrectly, pointing to the chapter you need to look back at
- 100% required in the test

When successfully completed, you get a digital badge.

BADGES

- Complete one of the 5 skill areas to get a badge
- Complete all 5 skill areas get the full badge

- It does not provide any qualifications. It enables learners to become qualification ready.



|The Planner Tool





|The Planner Tool

- Produces a personalised list of suggested courses.

- Mock tests available






Qualification details

- Size: 45 GLH at each level
- Coverage: each qualification covers all five of the skill areas from the national standards, and most of the skills statements in each skill area.
- Purposes and target learner groups:
 - Entry 3 skills for life with an introduction to skills for work;
 - Level 1 skills for life and work.

Assessment structure and timings

| Qualification | Entry level 3 | Level 1 |

| Duration | Up to 1 hour 30 minutes plus a 15 minute supervised break plus observed tasks within a 14-day period | 1 hour 45 minutes plus a 15 minute supervised break in between Parts 1 and 2. |
| Conditions | Supervised conditions | Supervised conditions |
| Total marks | 44 | 54 |
