

### The Global Digital & Technology Skills Shortage



4.3 M \$449.7 B

Over half (54%) of the organisations agreed that the digital talent gap is hampering their digital transformation programs.

Overall, 29% of employees believe their skill set is redundant now or will be in the next 1–2 years.

51% of employees lack hard digital skills (globally). It's estimated that by 2030, technology, media and telecommunications (TMT) industries will be faced with a global skills gap of 4.3 million people.

In total, these shortages are predicted to cost the TMT industries \$449.7 billion in unrealised revenue.






### The UK landscape

- 7.6 million jobs displaced by CV-19
- 9/10 organisations have a digital skills gap
- £74,000 average salary for developers in 2020
- Despite CV-19 and Brexit the tech sector is expected to grow by 13%
- Software developers and engineers are most in demand digital job worldwide

### Coding Industry

Across Europe there are an ever-increasing number of jobs in software development, however, traditional 3/4 year computer science programmes cannot meet the demand.

### Unit 4 Full Stack Frameworks with Django Level 6 190 GLH Credits: 25

Build a full stack web application. Understanding and skills building on those in Module 3: python-based, Django framework incorporating APIs, routing, data manipulation, automated testing, user authentication and e-commerce functionality, use of relevant tools (integrations, testing tools)
