Task 5: Create a social media poster (9 marks)

Candidate instructions

You volunteer for a local charity and the manager has asked you to create a social media poster to promote their online charity sale.

Download the files Sale and Heart.

a) Use a suitable application to copy and paste all the text from **Sale** into a document to create your poster. (1 mark)

b) Make the title font bold **and** underline. (2 marks)

c) Add the image file, **Heart**, to the poster and position it appropriately. (2 marks)

d) Add bullet points to the list of items that have been donated. (1 mark)

e) Make the poster attractive and easy to read. You must use

- different font sizes
- different font colours
- text alignment.

| a) 1 mark for copying and pasting all text from the file Sale into a suitable document for editing. (115 words) | 1 |

| e) 1 mark for each of these features used to make presentation of text attractive: use of different font sizes (minimum of two font sizes) to award mark) use of different colours (use of at least one colour in addition to black) use of text alignment, e.g. centre, justify or right-align (do not award if tabs or character spacing has been used to align text) | 3 |
