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





### Primary research

- Letters, wills, charters, laws, treaties, diaries, film footage, photographs, physical objects
- Questionnaires, interviews, observations, case studies,
- Court and Parliament transcripts, legal documents, statutes and other government papers, contemporary political posters and manifestos
- Research studies or scientific experiments
- Texts of novels, plays, poems
- Paintings and sculptures
- Letters and diaries of artists and writers


#### Ethical research

Key points to consider include the following:

- Respect, privacy, dignity, safety, human rights and well-being of all participants.
- Valuing diversity within the community.
- Honesty and openness when informing participants about their role
- Personal competence and scientific integrity.
- Accountability for the project.



# Grading

When grading learner work, make sure that you:

- take a holistic approach
- use your professional judgement
- give a Pass if the work doesn't achieve the standard required for Merit



### Effective feedback

- Be factual, clear and concise
- Be consistent in approach
- Commentary should be for the whole assignment and not against ACs
- Commentary should be developmental and individual to the student
- Feedback should offer areas to improve
- Use the correct terminology "very good" (merit) or "excellent" (distinction)


