Legal Entitlement - Essential Digital Skills

National entitlement introduced in 2020 to fully fund eligible adults with no or low digital skills to enrol on specified digital qualifications at Entry and Level 1


Only Essential Digital

Qualifications available at Entry 3 and Level 1 funded for both adults and 16-19 learners




Profile of EDSQ learners

- Size:
 - 45 GLH at each level
- Coverage:
 - Each qualification covers all five strands of the national standards and most of the skills statements in each strand.
- Purposes and target learner groups:
 - E3 skills for life with an intro to skills for work;
 - Level 1 skills for life and work.

Task and Skill	Task set	Marks Available	Marks awarded	Tutor Comments (where relevant please note where you have adapted tasks in line with the requirements).
Apply system settings	Change a setting on your device. For example, you could: change the way your screen looks (display) change the time or language make changes to suit your level of vision or hearing. Make sure your tutor can see you making the changes.	1 mark for changing the setting		
Create, edit and use contacts when sending and receiving online communications	Exemplar task – this may be adapted Your tutor (or someone else in your class who is not already in your contacts) will send you an email. The emails says, 'Now you have my email' Add the person and their email address to the contacts on your device. The same person will give you a telephone number (this could be the centre's number) Edit your contacts to add the telephone number Show your tutor the contact with phone number and email address OR take a screenshot and send it to them.	2 marks for adding name and email address 1 mark for editing the contact		
Initiate and participate in a video call	Make a video call to one other person. You can choose which device you use which way you want to make the call (e.g. Skype, WhatsApp or Facetime). who you want to call. Your video call should last at least 30 seconds. Make sure your tutor can see you making the call.	4 marks in total 1 mark for finding and connecting 2 marks for initiating and responding 1 mark for closing the conversation


Tasks are tutor assessed, centre and AO quality assured
