





It is essential that we invest in education and training for the over 30 million people already in the workforce, giving them the skills they need to progress..

...we need to offer them the opportunity to upskill and reskill over their careers

Many Londoners are stuck in, or moving in and out of, low-income, insecure employment with few chances to progress into better-paid and more stable jobs...So upskilling is an important way of tackling inwork poverty

Research has shown that half (49%) of adults from the lowest socioeconomic group receive no training at all after leaving school, compared to 20% from the top group

The poorest adults with the lowest qualifications are the least likely to access adult training – despite being the group who would benefit most

What makes Access to HE special?

- Provides a second chance and opens doors previously closed
- Learner loans are paid off for the Access to HE year once students complete their undergraduate degree
- Equivalent to 3 A-levels delivered in one academic year
- Provides a standalone qualification
- Designed to meet local needs
- Revalidated every 5 years, so is up to date and relevant
- Accrues UCAS points
- Enables entry on to year 1, degree programmes
- Offers a range of assessment methods, rather than end of year exams
