The National Context

National entitlement to fully fund eligible adults with no or low digital skills to enroll on specified digital qualifications at Entry level and Level 1 since August 2020

Only certain qualifications can be used for the adult legal entitlement

IT User Qualifications have been defunded

Essential Digital Skills qualifications are available at Entry 3 and Level 1 for both adults and 16-19 learners Digital Functional Skills qualifications will be available at Entry 3 and Level 1 for both adults and 16-19 learners from August 2023

Provide reliable evidence of a student's achievements against content that is relevant to the workplace and real life



Creating and Editing DFSQ Level 1

- 2.1 Use suitable applications (including word-processing, document or web presentation software), to enter, edit, format, layout, and save information (including text, tables, graphics and charts) for a range of purposes and audiences
- 2.2 Use appropriate layout conventions for information (including formal and informal communication, presentation, and advertisement) and audiences (including familiar and unfamiliar audiences)
- 2.3 Edit (including caption, crop, resize, change contrast, change colour balance) an image using an appropriate tool
- 2.4 Process numeric data using simple formulae (including sum, subtraction, multiplication, division, maximum, and average) using relative cell references
- 2.5 Process (including sort and filter) numeric data by using values in a column
- 2.6 Format numeric data (including font sizes, font styles, alignment, cell formatting, merging cells, splitting cells, row height, column width)
- 2.7 Chart a single series of numeric data using an appropriate type of chart and apply suitable titles and labels (including chart title, axis titles, data legends and data labels)

To support centres in placing their learners on the most appropriate level of qualifications we have developed the following initial assessment tools.

Digital Functional Skills Qualifications Initial Assessment Tool

Instructions

This pack contains two simple initial assessment tools for use with learners considering undertaking Digital Functional Skills qualifications (DFSQ).

The Basic Suitability Assessment should be completed by all learners, it will help determine if learners are ready for Digital Functional Silial Qualifications or it they would benefit from first doing some additional preparation. The eight questions are short and straightforward and most learners should be able to use this tool independently.

The Strengths and Weaknesses Assessment should be completed by learners deemed ready by the first tool. It will assist tutors in identifying which level of Digital Functional Skills is Usely to be most appropriate for a learner, it will also show where learners's trengths and weaknesses lie.

The questions on this second, longer, assessment are separated into the five Essential Digital Sidiil areas. They contain a mixture of questions based on the digital standards at Entry 3 and Level 1. As there are a total of 37 questions in this tool and some technical terms are used, some learners may need support to complete this assessment. For example, they may need help with reading the questions, understanding some of the terminology, or with maintaining focus as they work their way through it.

Each tool offers learness the opportunity to receive an email containing a breakdown of their results, which is especially relevant for the second tool where their answers will reveal strengths and weeknesses. If learness do not have a suitable email you may wich to provide them with an email address to use that will enable you to collate and analyse the results afterwards. Emails will come from notifications///typeform.com, if you do not receive an email, please check your junit indice or assist learners to do iso.

Results Checker

Once a learner has completed the Strengths and Weaknesses Assessment, they will receive a "score" in the confirmation email, you can use the below Score Checker tool to quickly look up which lived of Digital Functional Skills qualification is likely to be most appropriate.




