Legal Entitlement Essential Digital Skills

National entitlement was introduced in 2020 to fully fund eligible adults (with no or low digital skills) to enrol on specified digital qualifications at Entry and Level 1


Only Essential Digital Skills Qualifications can be used for the adult legal entitlement




Entry 3 and Level 1 Qualifications are funded for both adults and 16-19 learners
