The National Context

National entitlement to fully fund eligible adults with no or low digital skills to enroll on specified digital qualifications at Entry level and Level 1 since August 2020

Only certain qualifications can be used for the adult legal entitlement

IT User Qualifications have been defunded

Essential Digital Skills qualifications are available at Entry 3 and Level 1 for both adults and 16-19 learners

Digital Functional Skills qualifications will be available at Entry 3 and Level 1 for both adults and 16-19 learners from August 2023



Digital Functional Skills Qualifications Purpose



Provide reliable evidence of a student's achievements against content that is relevant to the workplace and real life



Provide assessment of a student's knowledge and skills as well as their ability to apply these in different contexts



Provide a foundation for progression into employment or further education and develop skills for everyday life

New Skills Fund: Funding bands

There will be 5 new skills funding bands, with sector subject areas (SSAs) at tier 2 level assigned to one of these bands

A simple calculation: GLH x relevant skills band hourly rate

New hourly skills funding rate	£6.00	£7.20	£8.40	£9.60	£12.00



Digital Functional Skills funding rates 2024/2025

We will treat the new digital qualification as if it is in the ICT for users SSA from 2024 to 2025, meaning the funding rate for the new digital functional skills qualifications will increase to £462

The new hourly rate for ICT users SSA is £8.40 and GLH for these qualifications is 55 hours.



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
