

Entry Level Certificate in Mathematics (Entry 1)

Summary of Changes

Purpose of Update: Following a scheduled review of this qualification, changes have been made to ensure that the qualification remains fit for purpose, relevant and engaging.

The qualification has been assigned its own specification to enhance usability and to ensure that centres can navigate the information more efficiently. As there have been no registrations for units positioned more than one level above or below the qualification's core level, a decision has been taken to withdraw these units from the optional unit group. This change is intended to streamline the registration process for centres by making it easier to identify and select the appropriate unit at the correct level.

The information below details what specific changes have been made for teaching from 1st August 2026 onwards.
